

Summer Camp Counselor ***Coloma Outdoor Discovery School***

The Coloma Outdoor Discovery School (CODS), a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization, has been providing a variety of outdoor education programs since 1990. CODS offers public and private school students a 1-5 day experience into the following areas: California history, science, and *Team Discovery* ropes challenge. Our campus is located on the banks of the South Fork of the American River in the town of Coloma, California. In addition to the traditional programs, CODS will be hosting two sessions of *Adventure Camp*.

Each session of *Adventure Camp* begins on Sunday afternoon and commences the following Friday afternoon. *Adventure Camp* is jam-packed with activities such as hiking, swimming, kayaking, climbing and white water rafting—all with the intention of motivating children to go beyond perceived boundaries and encouraging group cooperation.

CODS is accepting applications for *Adventure Camp* Counselors. Two Counselors in conjunction with one CODS staff member will supervise each group of 15 campers for daytime activities. In addition, each Counselor will be responsible for supervising a same gender bunkhouse of 8-10 campers Sun.-Thurs. night. Counselors will alternate in providing a free-time activity option for campers.

- Excellent communication and leadership skills
- The ability to work independently as well as cooperatively with others
- Physical stamina☺ and a love of the outdoors
- A creative, fun, and energetic personality!
